– son of Æthelred Unraed and Ælflaed of Northumbria

Sweyn Forkbeard (r. 1013–1014)

– son of King Harald Bluetooth of Denmark and Gunild

Cnut the Great (r. 1016–1035)

– son of Sweyn Forkbeard

Harold Harefoot (r. 1035–1040)

– son of Cnut and Ælfgifu of Northampton

Harthacanute (r. 1040–1042)

– son of Cnut and Emma of Normandy

West Saxons (restored)

Edward the Confessor (r. 1042–1066)

– son of Æthelred Unraed and Emma of Normandy

Harold Godwinson (r. 5 January – 14 October 1066)

– son of Godwin, earl of Wessex and Gytha Thorkelsdóttir

Edgar the Atheling (r. 15 October – 10 December 1066)

– son of Edward the Exile, grandson of Edmund Ironside

Normans

William I, the Conqueror (r. 25 December 1066–1087)

– illegitimate son of Robert II, duke of Normandy, and Herleva

William II, Rufus (r. 1087–1100)

– son of William the Conqueror and Matilda of Flanders

Henry I, Beauclerc (r. 1100–1135)

– son of William the Conqueror and Matilda of Flanders

Stephen of Blois (r. 1135–1154)

– son of Stephen, count of Blois and Adela of Normandy

Henry II (r. 1154–1189)

– son of Geoffrey, count of Anjou, and Matilda

Richard I, Lionheart (r. 1189–1199)

– son of Henry II and Eleanor of Aquitaine

John I, Lackland (r. 1199–1216)

– son of Henry II and Eleanor of Aquitaine

Henry III (r. 1216–1272)

– son of John Lackland and Isabella of Angoulême

Edward I, Longshanks (r. 1272–1307)

– son of Henry III and Eleanor of Provence
